# Welcome


In March 2020 the world changed for all of us.

Here at Woking Dance Space we were deep into rehearsals for our Joining Forces show. Guest dancing groups had been invited, choreography prepared, costumes made, tickets sold, and the dancers were ready. Then came lockdown and the studie fall eilent for the longest period since its

and the studio fell silent for the longest period since its creation in 1995.

We all listened to the news, everyone predicted that the lockdown would be over in two weeks, it was just a temporary inconvenience. Early half-term break, back after Easter and the Show would go ahead in May as originally scheduled. But it didn't...

So, like everyone else around the country, around the world, we adapted. Spare bedrooms and dining rooms that had hastily been converted into offices also became our personal dance studios.





Our classes were held over Zoom, with the inevitable technical problems of internet services or 4G coverage. Choreography was limited by the furniture (or the dog) but we prevailed.

Our online access became the only way to get our dance 'fix'. We did our best to

support the live performance community by streaming plays, musicals, ballets and other events. We entered the video of our Joining Forces ballet number into an online dance competition, and won first place! We posted childhood pictures and played 'guess the baby dancer'. Slowly, hesitantly, we returned to our studio for face to face classes, but only limited numbers were allowed, twelve in a class where previously we could have had up to thirty. Entry was via the spiral fireescape stairs, and we had to keep the windows open all year round for ventilation. The show was postponed again in 2021, but we persevered.

Now **We're Back**, back to a full timetable of classes, and back to performing on stage! We have new dancers who found us online during lockdown, or joined us face to face when we re-opened. We have added new classes, and the studio even had a lick of new paint!

We missed our  $25^{th}$  anniversary during lockdown, so please join us in celebrating our  $27^{th}$  anniversary in 2022. Throughout the time the studio has existed our core purpose has remained unchanged. We continue to welcome



adult dancers of all ages and of all abilities.

The show you are going to see this evening contains much emotion, exuberance and the sheer enjoyment we all find in dancing. We are so glad to be back. Thank you for coming.
